Student Services

- Support and encourage students to work a recovery program in the school setting
- Provide guidance and support for educational/emotional issues
- Support teachers in providing for the behavioral needs of students with IEPs
- Address health issues during the school day
- Offer spiritual support for students in the school environment
- Act as a strong member of the student support team
- Manage student behavior (in the school environment and at school sponsored events)
- Facilitate daily check-in
- Communicate student needs and behavior concerns to families/teams
- Communicate student successes and accomplishments to families/teams
- Discuss behavior recorded on point sheets with team
- Develop behavior contracts and action plans with students
- Perform random drug screening
- Work on recovery plans with kids
- Address any return to use proactively
- Perform recovery interviews with new students
